

Health promotion & drinking water supply in Laos



Training of people in 100 remote villages in Bokeo province, for them to know how to deal with the most common diseases and to provide First Aid in an emergency. Construction of 30 water supply systems and 3,000 latrines in different villages (10 villages per annum) as well as provision of hygiene trainings.

Water committees are being established in every village, which will be trained in the maintenance and repair of the systems. Through the project, the capacities of the Lao Red Cross are being strengthened for the co-operation with the health authorities at provincial and district level to strengthen the capacities of health, water and sanitation activities in the Bokeo province. The activities take place in all five districts of Bokeo province and in total 100 villages and 30.000 people will be supplied with clean drinking water.

Project aim:

Implementation of local health projects and construction of water systems and latrines for provision of drinking water.
